



ORIGINI Italy Programme – 2015

Participation Guidelines

ITA (Italian Trade Agency) and MIB School of Management (Trieste, Italy) promote and organize **Origini Italy Programme**, an intensive **Entrepreneurial Development** course, aimed at the descendants of emigrants from Italy who are residents abroad, in particular from extra European countries. The objective of the course is to encourage a new and productive collaboration between those descendants and the Italian business system (for further information please read the brochure opening http://mib.edu/en/master/origini-course/origini).

The course has a maximum of **30 places** and applicants should be between the ages of 25 and 35. The candidate profile is a young graduate, preferably with some years of work experience, who is interested in acquiring international entrepreneurial and managerial education, with the aim to establish new business relations with the companies working in Italy.

Classes will be held in English. The basic knowledge of Italian will be, however, an advantage for the applicant during selections.

The Course will last for a period of 20 weeks from **Monday July 13th 2015** to **Saturday November 14th 2015**. Classes will be held at MIB School of Management (Palazzo del Ferdinandeo, Largo Caduti di Nasiryia 1, Trieste, Italy) and at ITA (Italian Trade Agency, Via Liszt 24, Rome, Italy).

Applications for the programme, along with a Curriculum Vitæ (please follow the European Standard model, https://europass.cedefop.europa.eu/en/documents/curriculum-vitae/templates-instructions), a short motivation letter and eventual letters of reference, should be submitted by e-mail or fax to MIB School of Management no later than **Tuesday March 31**st 2015. Participant selection will take place in April-May 2015.

MIB School of Management guarantees successful applicants travel expenses (a return flight from their country of residence to Trieste, Italy), accommodation expenses for the duration of the course. Both during classroom lessons and the internship participants will also be guaranteed lunch on the premises.
